

# Golf Cart Rules

This is a busy family oriented campground. For safety reasons, the same rules that apply for motor vehicles on our roads and highways do apply in our campground. Your cart can be a fun vehicle if driven properly and leisurely, but a hazard if driven carelessly.

## Rules of the Road:

- Solo drivers must have a valid G2 or G driver's license. Young drivers must produce proof of this if asked.
- Adult campers without a license, but still able to safely drive a cart, may do so at our discretion.
- Drivers with a beginners license must be with a parent at all times and show proof of that license when approached.
- Cart max speed is 15km/hr.
- No alcohol to be consumed on the cart.
- No driving while under the influence.
- Screaming, hollering, abusive language and boisterous behaviour will not be tolerated.
- The number of riders will equal the number of seats.
- Speeding, racing and cart overload is dangerous and not permitted.
- At 11pm your cart must be back on your site and stay there until 8am the next morning.

## Each Cart Must Have:

- Front and rear lights if driven after dusk.
- Site numbers at least 3" tall on each side of the cart.
- Be properly insured with copy of proof given to office.
- Only electric carts are allowed in the Park.
