

Camper Code of Conduct 2021

This code is in effect from the 23 day of April, 2021.

Campers,

Welcome to The Park! Please read this Code of Conduct (the Code) and review it with all family members. The rules in this Code must be followed to ensure we all stay safe and do not engage in activities that contravene any Provincial or Federal Government regulations and ensure we comply with all health regulations. It is important to remember that, ultimately, we are all in charge of our own health and safety. Please remember to bring a mask and gloves or hand sanitizer for the occasion that you will need it.

This Code is over and above our normal campground rules, which still apply. Strict enforcement of all rules will be in place for all registered names on your occupancy agreement. Any camper, regardless of age who breaches this Code will be asked to leave the campground immediately and your Licence of Occupation may be cancelled.

If you or anyone on your site, has a fever or flu-type symptoms, stay home. If you or anyone on your site have tested positive for COVID-19, are a presumptive case, or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a presumptive case, do not attempt to enter the campground. Please remain at your residence until you have been cleared by your local health department and/or you have finished your self-isolation of 14 days.

At this time, we will be operating under the following rules. These rules may change as the Ontario or Federal Government amends legislation.

Common Areas

All areas that are closed are indicated with a sign. If you are unsure whether something is closed or not, please contact the office for clarification.

Walking around the Campground

At all times campers must obey social distancing rules and gathering laws as mandated by the Province of Ontario. You must stay 2 meters or 6 feet away from other campers. You may use walking trails if social distancing rules are followed.

Children and those Under the age of 18

We expect that all parents will ensure their children obey the rules. If your children cannot follow these rules, please do not bring them to the campground at this time.

Events/Activities

Events and Activities that can be undertaken obeying all social distancing and gathering restrictions will be allowed.

Stay at Home Order

During the Stay At Home Order, campers with Seasonal Contracts that are coming to their trailer, must choose to come either for 14 days or more, or stay for less than 24hrs.

Office/Store

Please do not enter the office if you see another customer already inside. Please line up outside of the office and obey all social distancing rules. If you are coming into the office and/or store, please wear a mask and practice social distancing. If you need to sign any documentation, please bring your own pen.

Visitors

You are accountable for your visitors. Please ensure that they are following this Code of Conduct.

Visitors allowed in the campground depend on the colour of the Region. The colour may change from time to time and may be different from the region you live in.

GREY LOCKDOWN	No visitors allowed in the campground.
RED – CONTROL	Visitors allowed. You are allowed up to 10 people in total on our site. Infants, children and yourself all count towards your 10 people. No overnight visitors, unless they are registered as additional Seasonal campers to your site. No tents. Visitors are not allowed on campground property between the hours of 11pm and 9am.
ORANGE- RESTRICT	Visitors allowed. You are allowed up to 10 people in total on our site. Infants, children and yourself all count towards your 10 people.
YELLOW - PROTECT	Visitors allowed. You are allowed up to 10 people in total on our site. Infants, children and yourself all count towards your 10 people.
GREEN – PREVENT	Normal visitor rules apply.
